

Key principles when studying the Qur'an



1. Understand that the Qur'an...

- ...is taught and meanings made clear by Allah (55:1-2), (75:19)
- ...has been made easy (54:17, 54:22, 54:32, 54:40)
- ...is **fully detailed** (7:52, 11:1-2)
- ...is **an excellent tafsir** itself (25:33)
- ...is clear/makes things distinct (22:15), (12:1), (15:1), (27:1), (28:2), (43:2), (44:2)
- ...is the **criteria** for right and wrong, truth and falsehood (25:1)
- ...contains **no contradictions** (4:82)

2. When studying it, we should...

- ...not rush to conclusions, take time, study all the related verses (20:114)
- ...evaluate and ponder over the message, reflect, critically evaluate others' understanding of the meaning (4:82, 23:68, 25:73, 38:29, 47:24, 2:111)
- ...have a pure/clear mind, no preconceived notions, ideas or conclusions (56:79)
- ...give full attention and silence inner tendencies (including inner protests about it not conforming to preconceptions (7:204)
